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Background

The Karen people have a racial tie to nature. They live and love nature. The Karen lives in the forest and work as farmers, but lack of education living in a remote area and poverty affects quality of life and readiness to go out into the world. Karen children and youth are not prepared to live in the city to hope to gain more education and economic opportunities. But these young people are unable to live in the city in order to gain self-improvement, but instead hurt their future. Therefore, the Karen Leadership Development Foundation foresee the problems that arise with these children and youth groups. Therefore, a foundation was established to help support and build these children and youth who will receive education, develop one's potential pass on this opportunity to those who will not get the next opportunity and return to strengthen the community to be a good and efficient leader who creates benefits for society and the country.

3. Rationale:

Karen people have cultural ties to nature. They live in and love nature. Karen people live in the forest and primarily make their living as farmers. Living in a remote and isolated area that is rooted in poverty does affect the quality of life for Karen children and most are not equipped to thrive in the city – where education and employment are found. Young Karen come to the city with hopes and dreams and expectations. They are not prepared and often overwhelmed, and in the end damage their future.

The Karen Leadership Development Foundation (KLDF), anticipating the problems that face these groups of children and youth, established a foundation to help support, build-up and educate them – each to their unique potential. In passing on this opportunity to those without, we in turn strengthen the community. Creating servant leaders, we benefit not only the Karen, but Thailand and the world.







4. Purposes:

- 4.1 To promote all types of work and activities related to the development of children and youth at the local, national, and international levels.
- 4.2 To carry out educational work, support educational funds and other necessary factors for underprivileged children and youth to receive education so that they can earn an honest living and benefit society.
- 4.3 To provide training in various forms to develop the potential of children, youth and community leaders to have life skills, morality and ethics that can promote a good quality of life and create benefits for society.
- 4.4 To bring in volunteers from abroad to participate in and support projects in accordance with the objectives of the foundation and to coordinate integrated cooperation in related operations.
- 4.5 To be a center for volunteers, both Thai and foreign, in coordinating cooperation in helping and developing society both domestically and internationally in all forms.

Report of Operational Activities




